The Harrow Gospel Hall Trust would like to invite you to a public consultation event regarding the re-development of land at 265 The Ridgeway, Harrow.

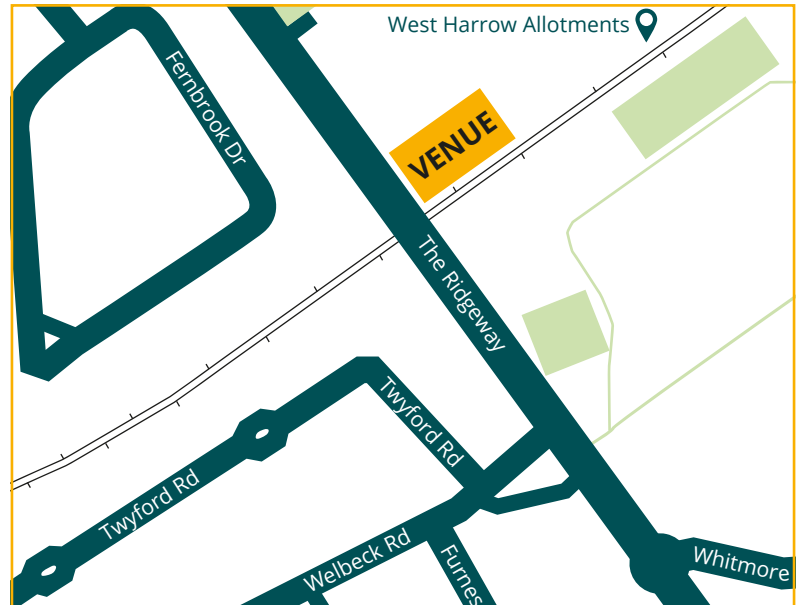
